

# WATERFRONT PARKS CENTENNIAL 1910 - 2010

## “PICTURE YOUR PARKS” JURIED PHOTO CONTEST RULES

The “Picture Your Parks” photo contest is a competition to promote the awareness, beauty and sustainability of the green necklace of waterfront parks that for 100 years have made downtown St. Petersburg a special place.

### Contest Categories

Each contest category will have an adult and a youth division. The youth division is for photographers under 18 years of age.

#### People in the Parks

Focus on the person or family as a part of the park environment

#### Nature in the Parks (Landscapes)

Focus on nature as part of the park environment, including the land, water & sky (may include incidental man-made objects)

#### Animals in the Parks

Focus on wild animals or pets in the park environment

#### Events in the Parks

Focus on activities associated with any of the many events held in the parks

### Eligible Parks

All photos must have been taken in or from one of the parks the subject of the Centennial Celebration including (south to north) Albert Whitted Park; Al Lang Stadium; Pioneer Park Demens Landing; North or South Straub Park; Spa Beach; Vinoy Park; North Shore Park; Elva Rouse Park; Gizella Kopsick Palm Arboretum; Flora Wylie Park

### Judging- NO DIGITALLY MANIPULATED IMAGES

Entries will be judged on composition, adherence to the theme, impact and creativity. Only standard color, tone, density, contrast, burning and dodging can be applied to digital images. Judging will be done by professional photographers. The Centennial Celebration Committee and judges reserve the right to refuse any photo deemed inappropriate or found not to comply with these rules.

### Awards (awarded separately for youth and adult divisions except for Best of Show)

Best of Show - \$250 (single award)  
First Place (each category, each division) - \$100  
Second Place (each category, each division) - \$50  
Third Place (each category, each division) – 25

Each award winner will be required to submit a finished print (at least 8 x 10), mounted with a mat size no larger than 16 x 20. Deadline for receipt of the mounted print is November 2. The mounted print will be displayed at “Party in the Parks” on Nov. 6.

### Entry Guidelines

- All photos must have been taken by the entrant.
- Submittal deadline is **October 1**.
- All entries must adhere to a category.
- Winners will be notified by email or phone.
- Maximum number of digital entries is 5.

Images, either black & white or color, must be in JPG format with a minimum size of 250K and a maximum size of 1 meg.

Each photo must be identified with your name (first and last) and the first word from the photo category for which the photo is being submitted. If entrant is under 18 precede your name with y for youth division submittal.
